Expanding Our Care Services and Enhancing Our Projects

2019 has been another exciting year for Hartfield Health, marked by significant expansions and improvements across our operations. We acquired an adult supported living business in the form of The Lodge, a supported living adult care business in Sussex to be known as Wellgate Supported Living. We also continued to make improvements at MNP our residential care business in Kent. We continued the process of recruiting further important team members, made progress in the swim and childcare projects and our food business in Africa was launched, having set up in 2018.

Acquisition of The Lodge, Bexhill

In March 2019, we expanded our care services by acquiring The Lodge, a supported living business in Bexhill, Sussex. Now operating as Wellgate Supported Living, The Lodge offers 12 ensuite bedrooms, each designed to meet the specific needs of adults with autism and learning difficulties. The rooms have been newly refurbished, and the residents are delighted with the improvements. We've also introduced many new activities and initiatives to enhance their quality of life.



Enhancements at MNP Care

In Kent, our residential care business, MNP, continued to see upgrades and improvements. Our commitment to providing excellent care and support remains unwavering, and we are constantly working to ensure that our facilities meet the highest standards.

Welcoming New Team Members

In January 2019, we welcomed Henry Beynon as a Project Manager, working across both London Place and the Wellgate brand. His first major project involved the refurbishment of The Lodge in Sussex and the ongoing enhancement of our MNP facilities in Kent. Henry's expertise and dedication have already made a significant impact on our operations.



Children's Swim and Day Nursery Projects

Our children's swim centre project made significant strides this year. We secured planning permission to establish a state-of-the-art swim centre and café in the new Redrow building on Chiswick High Road. This new facility will complement the existing swim centre operated by First Swim in Twickenham.

In addition, our children's day nursery initiatives received planning approval for new sites in Acton, Barnes, and Greenwich. These developments represent our ongoing commitment to providing high-quality childcare services in the London area.

Launching Our Food Business in Africa

We are thrilled to announce the successful launch of our food business in Africa. Led by Timothy Kabandaze, this venture focuses on the manufacture and distribution of bread and other bakery products in western Uganda.
